From The Director's Desk

Currently if we do not get any snow, our last day of school will be 6/14/18. We will be closed for a Teacher work day 6/15 and start Summer Session 6/18/17.

Spring is starting to peek through the end of winter and show us signs of new growth. It amazes me each year to see the growth that is happening to the children as the end of the year approaches. You can see how comfortable they are and the new skills they have developed.

Please remember that we ask children to arrive by 9:15 to 9:20 each morning so they can participate in circle time. If you arrive later, have your child enter the group quietly or arrive after group time is finished. Please take conversations outside so you do not disturb classes. Keep in mind that our Preschool class is in the same room as the time clock. It is hard to continue a group time & projects with late arrivals caus-

ing interruptions. Thank you to all for not walking through the Stargazer class once they have started.

Parents received Developmental Screenings 90 days after the children started this fall. Teachers offered parent conferences and talked with individual parents about the learning they have seen your child do this year. Teachers post & e-mail their lesson plans for parents. They are posted to the web site. Please feel free to set up a conference with your teacher at any time as we finish up the school year.

I want to thank you all for turning in re-enrollment forms in a timely manner. You will find confirmation letters in your Parent Pocket. I was able to accommodate all schedule change requests. I know a lot can change before September so please let me know if you have any schedule changes ASAP. Please let me know if you do not receive a confirmation letter and schedule by March 8th. Reminders:

- When you arrive please take children to their classes first and then log in on the time clock. When you pick up please log them out on the time clock first and then pick them up from their group. This eliminates congestion in the lobby,
- Children are not allowed to go to the barn, bathroom or parking lot unsupervised by parents during drop off and pick up. **Students need to be supervised 100% of the time while on school grounds.**
- As the warm weather approaches children often take off coats and hats. Please check the lost but found basket. Make sure you are taking home **YOUR** child's clothing. Several children have the same coats and shoes and some have gone missing. We will **donate unclaimed items at the end of each month** if the basket is full. We check for kids names first.
- We ask children not to share items to prevent the spread of germs/bugs. PLEASE label anything they can take off themselves!
- Please **clean out your child's cubby** and make sure they have a change of clothes that fit them that is appropriate for the season.
- **As you do your spring cleaning at home keep us in mind!** We need boys and girls underwear and pants in size 3 to 6, paint brushes, tents, hand towels and other real tools you use around the house.
- Only and Plus schedules can drop off as early as 8:30 AM without an additional charge, full day as early as 7:00 AM.

- Please wait on the hill until a parking spot is open.

Time Clock Requirements

If you don't clock in, you can't clock out. If you don't clock out you can't clock in the next day. If you get an error message that says "See the Director" it means your log in/out is out of order and you need to use the correction sheet until it is checked off, meaning it is corrected. If the time clock is not working please sign in/out on the correction sheet.

I am finding that parents are moving too fast and not waiting for all the prompts or are forgetting to **press finish for a second time** after the machine confirms you are checking in or out.

When you check your child in/out you can also hit the options button and check your balance to date before hitting finish the last time. You can also log in at myprocare.com and check statements and contact info.

It is required to clock or sign your child in and out each day. I need to know who is picking up/dropping off and at what time. This is mandated by The Department of Early Learning. Thank you for your help keeping your child safe, we check school wide attendance for fire drills. **Please make sure your child is accounted for by the time clock or on the correction sheet daily.**
