Summer & Fall Reminders:

- If you will **not** be attending summer your September tuition is due **June 1, 2021** to hold your space over the summer. This pre-payment is **non-refundable after July 1, 2021.**
- Children remain in their class fall through summer and move to the next class in Fall.
- Upon your start date you will be added to our e-mail lists and receive, menu's, events, newsletters, etc.
- The full Registration Packet and Transition Plan for visits can be found on the Registration Page of our web site. **Please turn in registration paperwork 3 to 4 weeks before your child is registered to start** at The Shyne School.
- Call to set up transition visits before your child starts at The Shyne School in their new class. **Transition Dates for Summer** are on June 8-15, 10:00 to 11:00 AM and **Fall** August 19 to 26th (*No visits 8/27 & 30*) & Aug 31 to Sept 7, 2021. One Adult must visit with the child.
- Parents need to visit and meet their child's new teacher. Find out where the cubbies, art file, parent board and parent pockets are located in your new class. See the classroom in action!

- Ask your new teacher if you have any questions about their class. ***Example: Children must be walking, drinking out of a sippy cup and taking one nap when starting in Dewdrops. Moving from Dewdrops to Rainbow the children will start potty training. We ask that you dress them in clothing they can take off and put on by themselves. Children moving to Stargazers/Sunshiners, Preschool/Pre-K, must be potty trained.***
